



Fifth Grade Parents,

This summer students will complete math review skills on IXL. Each child has a list of skills to master and should use the assignment tracker to track their progress. Students may begin **the first day of summer**. If they practice sooner, their work will not be saved (all data is cleared on the last day of school). While your child may work at their own pace, completion of the summer assignment (obtaining a minimum of 80% Smart Score in each skill) will be counted towards their first grade in math. A good pace is to work on 2 skills per week.

To get your child started:

1. Go to www.stjuderockville.org
2. Under the Academics tab, click on IXL
3. Enter username and password to sign in

4. Click on “Math” and navigate to **fifth grade**.
5. Select the specific skill to practice from the assignment tracker.

If you notice your child struggling, try a suggested **supporting skill**, located on the practice screen. IXL is adaptive and will adjust based on your child's demonstrated understanding of the material; therefore, the pace of the program is controlled by the student. All of your child's results are automatically saved, so they can practice from any device with an internet connection. For on-the-go practice, you can download IXL's free apps for the iPad, Android, or Kindle and sign in with your child's username and password.

The completed assignment tracker is due the first day of school and counts as the first 6th grade math assignment.

We hope you will encourage your son or daughter to use IXL regularly this summer and we look forward to seeing you in the fall!
