



1. Have script, pencil, eraser, and highlighter readily available.
2. School rules apply in the building. No phones. When you are not needed on stage: work on some homework, eat a snack, or watch quietly. Chromebooks may be provided for school work.
3. Respect your peers by refraining from talking during rehearsal. It distracts from the rehearsal process and slows everybody down.
4. Memorize music, blocking, and choreography ASAP. I will teach it once and review it once, and then it should be memorized.
5. If you are late/miss a rehearsal, schedule a meeting with Ms. Murphy or Ms. Sella before school or during lunch to catch up on what you missed.
6. Conflicts:
 - a. List of conflicts with the rehearsal schedule are due at your audition.
 - b. Anything not listed on this sheet is an unexcused absence (except for emergencies). 2 or more unexcused absences may result in dismissal from the show.
 - c. This is a safety issue. We need to know where you are.

In following these rules/expectations, we ensure that our rehearsal process will go smoothly and that we will have a great show. :)
