Inclement Weather Policy

(K-8) St. Jude Regional Catholic School follows the Montgomery County Public Schools policy regarding school closings due to inclement weather. St. Jude will alert the community using School Messenger (phone call & email), Facebook, and Twitter (@StJudeRCS). If Montgomery County schools are closed - we are closed. If Montgomery County schools are opening 2 hours late - classes begin at 10:10 A.M.

(Pre -K) In the case of inclement weather, we follow the Montgomery County Public School schedule for closings. If there is a 2 hour late delay, our class will start at 10:30am and if, during the day, schools are told to close early, we ask that you come as quickly and safely as possible to collect your child.

There is no before care when we have a delayed opening. Classes BEGIN at 10:10am and the doors open at 10am for K-8. Pre-K begins at 10:30am.




