Assignment: Create Your Own Shield

Read *The Lightning* Thief and create your own shield. The shield must have one or more signs from "Medieval Heraldry" on it. You should select symbols and/or signs that are special to you or to your family.

Shields, family crests, and coats of arms were very important during the Medieval Period (500 – 1400 AD). You will make a shield that represents your individual strengths, talents, and personal attributes (courage, fortitude, compassion, generosity....or any of the Virtues). This was done by knights of old according to the code of Chivalry. Medieval Knights began decorating their shields and armor as a way to distinguish combatants on the field of battle. This grew into the widespread practice of heraldry. Symbols for the shields must come from the existing symbols for "HERALDRY", which are found on the provided chart.

What do I have to do? The shield must have one or more signs from "Medieval Heraldry" on it. You should select symbols and/or signs that are special to you or to your family. For example, the fleur de Lis is a symbol for the Blessed Mother. If someone uses that sign on their shield, it indicates a devotion to her.

- The rubric is below. Use it as a checklist before turning in the assignment.
- This is **due on the first day of school**. Any assignments turned in after the first day will be counted as late and will lose points. Assignments will not be accepted more than 5 days late.

- 10. Select a book from the drop down list
- 11. Enter your reading date and time. Every time you read, enter the number of minutes you read into Log Reading Time!
- 12. Click SAVE
- 13. That's it! You have logged your reading time. If you said you finished your book, you will be asked to review it. Doing so gives you bonus RR Miles!
- 15. Students entering 5th and 6th grades must go to the Quizzes tab and click on the quiz for their grade. All questions must be answered on the website.
