



By signing the "Contract for Drama Club," we understand and agree that:

1. Attendance

- a. Student will submit a list of conflicts with the rehearsal schedule at the audition.
- b. Student will follow the rehearsal schedule and attend assigned rehearsals promptly.
- c. Family will schedule other commitments around the rehearsal schedule.
- d. Family will communicate unscheduled conflicts as soon as possible. Absences not communicated via the conflict sheet or in email are considered unexcused. Students with more than 2 unexcused absences may be dismissed from the production.

2. Rehearsals

- a. Student will follow guidelines set in the school handbook (ex: respect for adults).
- b. Student will bring script, pencil, eraser, and highlighter to rehearsals.
- c. Student will learn all notes as soon as directed, and rehearse outside of rehearsals.
- d. Students who miss rehearsal will schedule a meeting with the director to catch up.
- e. Student will refrain from excessive talking during rehearsal.
- f. Student will work on homework (Chromebooks may be provided), eat a snack, watch quietly, or rehearse their own parts when not needed on stage.
- g. Students must keep cell phones put away and on silent during rehearsals, or they will be taken. Communication must be done through the Main Office.
- h. Student will wear his or her school uniform unless told otherwise.
- i. Student may not bring food or drink onstage or backstage or eat in costume.
- j. Student will carefully handle only those properties assigned to him or her.
- k. Student will remain in the designated rehearsal area under the direct supervision of production staff.

3. Miscellaneous

- a. Parent(s) must volunteer. Opportunities will be shared throughout the year.
- b. Family financial commitment is included but not limited to: \$20 Participation Fee, \$20 T-Shirt Fee, \$20 Cast Party Fee, and costume pieces (prices will vary).
- c. Family is responsible for transportation. If a student is not picked up within 10 minutes, he or she will be sent to After-Care and families will be charged accordingly. Carpool arrangements can be facilitated.
- d. Cast and crew assignments are made at the discretion of the production staff. Ability level and commitment are taken into consideration.
- e. Student must maintain a C average in all core subjects or be dismissed from the production at the school's discretion.

Failure to comply with these guidelines may result in dismissal from the production at the discretion of the production staff and/or disciplinary action from school administrators.
